At this time, the Albemarle Charlottesville Regional Jail is limiting guest entry into the facility.

All Inmate visitation will be suspended this week effective 3/12/2020 until further notice.

Superintendent Martin Kumer along with his Command Staff will be re-assessing the situation weekly using the CDC's most recent updates while evaluating facility safety and security needs to determine when we will be able to resume visitation.
